One highlight I must mention was being asked to judge the Bluefaced Leicester and Mule classes at Tullamore Show in Southern Ireland at the beginning of August. My judging started at 1.30 p.m and class by class I got the job done and hopefully pleased most people with my choices. Currently, early November, most will be counting the sheep tupped by now and hoping they've made the right mating choices with old and new. Genetics have been on the minds of several members this year. Myrfyn Roberts attended an NSA meeting and workshop at Stoneleigh earlier in the year and I attended the second part a few weeks ago. Defra have £2.5 million worth of funding available for genetic work for UK breeds so it was important we attended.

The Association has been well represented around the British Isles again this year, with display stands at ScotSheep which this year was held in the picturesque setting of Ballantrae, South Ayrshire and at NSA Malvern. I would like to extend my sincere thanks to everyone who has helped with these one day specialist events again this year, providing

sheep for the stands and helping out with building of the stands. Your help is invaluable.

Shows 2018

The Association were in attendance with their display stands at The Balmoral Show, The Royal Highland Show, The Great Yorkshire Show and The Royal Welsh Show. All the shows provided excellent classes of Bluefaced Leicesters again this year. Many congratulations to all winners and champions, and to all exhibitors for turning out their sheep to such a high standard. Agri Expo was our final event of the year held at Borderway Mart, Carlisle, and thanks must go to all members who provided sheep for stands at these events this year. Thank you on behalf of the Association to all judges who took the time to attend these important shows and events in the Association's calendar.

Sales 2018

The female sales were held in January at Hawes, Carlisle and Ballymena. The Champion at a very wintery Hawes sale was a gimmer hogg from the Booth family, SMEARSETT selling at £5,000. They also attainted the top price on the day for a gimmer shearling selling at £7,000. At the Carlisle sale, the judging was split again this year into crossing type and traditional. The Champion in the crossing type section was a gimmer hogg from W C Porter & Son, RIDDINGS, selling at 4,200 gns. Top price in the crossing type section was for a homebred gimmer from C & D Hall, FIRTH selling at 6,500 gns. In the traditional classes, the Champion was awarded to an aged ewe from D Williams of the ELIAN Flock, which also took the top price on the day selling for 1,000 gns. At the Ballymena sale, held in very wintery weather conditions the Champion and top price on the day was for a gimmer hogg from J Adams & Sons, HOLMVIEW flock which sold for a new Northern Ireland region female record of 3,000 gns.

The numbers entered at this year's ram sales were similar to numbers entered in 2017. Trade at some centres showed breed averages dipping slightly, while at other centres averages increased again on previous years. With some centres achieving good clearances, while other centres struggled this year.

Top price for a crossing type shearling ram this year was brought out for sale from the Lord Family, HEWGILL at the Penrith sale selling at £16,500. Top price for a crossing type ram lamb was brought out for sale at Hawes from A & C Hunter, STEEL flock selling at £20,000. Top price for a traditional shearling ram this year was brought out for sale at the NSA Wales & Border ram sales from T R Harris, BONVILSTON selling for 12,000 gns. Top price for a traditional ram lamb was also brought out for sale at the NSA Wales & Border ram sales from the PIEL VIEW flock of S & C Thomason & Son selling for 5,000 gns.

Thank you on behalf of the Association to all our sponsors for their invaluable support at this year's sales. Also to the many judges who took the time to attend these important sales for the breed, and also to all Chief Stewards and Stewards for their time and help. I would like to thank all members who returned sale entry forms in good time for catalogue preparation again this year.

Replacement Tags

If you need to order replacement Bluefaced Leicester ear tags, this must be done through the Association office and not direct from the tag company. The following details are required: Bluefaced Leicester side of the tag details; UK flock number with individual number; your CPH number. If it is a bought in animal and not your own breeding we require proof of purchase – either by supply of the original tag you are replacing or an Auctioneers invoice (this will be returned to you once the order is placed). If all this information can be supplied at the time of ordering, then it will allow us to improve the service to you the members. There is normally a five day turn around on replacement tag orders from the date of order. There is no charge for supply of replacement Bluefaced Leicester tags for 2018.

Grassroots Online Database

Members have free access to the online database system – Grassroots, and this can be found through a link on the Association's website - **www.blueleicester.co.uk**. Access is through a unique passcode individual to each member, and once you have gained access to the site you can 'manage' your flock on line. The following tasks can be done



by members: lamb registrations, transfer sheep off your holding which have either been sold, or have died. The following tasks can not be done by members: animal details can not be amended. Any additional stock purchased can not be added to your flock. For any of these tasks to be done, you will need to contact the office with the details to be added/ corrected, and the office will make the changes for you. If you have forgotten your Grassroots password, please contact the office and we will be happy to send you a reminder.

GDPR – Changes in Data Protection

Due to the changes in Data Protection which came in to force on the 25th May 2018, we now need members consent for the Bluefaced Leicester Sheep Breeders' Association to collect and process personal data in accordance with our privacy policy. A copy of which can be viewed on our website or a printed copy can be supplied on request from the office. If you have not yet completed and returned your consent form and would like another copy, please contact the office and we will send another form out to you for completion.

Export Register

If you would like to be included on the export register, please contact the office with your flock number, prefix and a valid e-mail address and you will be added to the register. This is when enquiries come in from abroad from people looking to import Bluefaced Leicester Genetics, and you will be notified of their request.

Performance Recording

There is an opportunity for members who Performance Record to claim back monies to assist with Performance Recording costs. If you are a Performance Recording member, and wish to make a claim, please send copy of your AHDB invoices for membership and scanning (this invoice must show the number of Bluefaced Leicester lambs scanned). The 50% refund will be arranged for you from the Association office, and the monies available are on a 'first come first served' basis.

MV Testing

There is an opportunity for members who MV test their flock of Bluefaced Leicesters to claim back monies to help towards the cost of testing. If you wish to make a claim, please send copy of your invoice from your vet clearly stating the number of Bluefaced Leicesters tested and the \pounds 2 per sheep refund will be arranged for you from the Association office. The monies available are on a 'first come first served' basis.

Gift Aid

This is of no additional cost to members, and provides a very useful financial input into the Association funds. If you have not already signed up to Gift Aid, or would like more information, then please contact the office for an application form.

After weeks of red hot temperatures and blue skies missing any clouds, the weather had to break sometime. No doubt the organisers of the Penrith Show wouldn't have minded if it had held on for a few more hours, after a deluge in the morning brought on reminders of last year's show, albeit the ground underfoot was good to firm, in race horse terms! Still the skies cleared just in time for the start of the judging and stayed clear for most of the time whilst judging was ongoing.

There was a legend in the making amongst the pens of sheep on show. There hasn't been a tup at the show made his presence felt quite so much as the aptly named "Jackpot" since the start of the progeny classes here at Penrith. Carry House Jackpot was purchased out of Hawes in 2016 for £14,000, selling to M/s Porter at Riddings and Martyn Archer retaining a share himself. He is a combination of some of the best bloodlines within the crossing world, sired by a son of Midlock Mustang and out of a ewe by the legendry Z4 Hundith which has set a benchmark for quality and consistency within the breed. Geoffrey and Val Porter, Riddings were the main beneficiaries of Jackpot's gualities on a near perfect day for the Riddings flock, where they took the Champion and Reserve Champion progeny in the crossing classes with their gimmer shearlings and gimmer lambs respectively, and then took the Reserve Mule progeny group with three gimmer lambs by Jackpot. Just ousting them out of the hotly contested Mule section was Martyn Archer with three cracking lambs sired by non-other than Jackpot again! Some result for the tup, who was still looking good and full of power.

The Riddings flock also took both Championship places in the crossing open show too, with a lovely gimmer shearling claiming the red blue and white ticket. This long, tall sheep is by the homebred "Thumper" which goes back to a tup they bought off Scarrowmanick some years back and its mother is by the E22 Domino. It is the first time out in the showring and she certainly looked the part, strutting her stuff, catching the eye of

judge, Richard Ellis. Their Reserve Champion was an aged ewe by C3 Midlock, "Badger" and out of the twin sister to Mr Cool, who has been the flock's best Mule getter over the past few years.

In the traditional section, the prizes were shared out more evenly, with no one flock having a monopoly of the tickets. The Champion in the progeny section went to Robin Peart on his debut at the show with three gimmer lambs by K3 Whinnyhall purchased at Carlisle last year with Jack Wilkinson, Bollihope. One of the lambs had already stood third at the Highland Show earlier this year before picking up second and third here at Penrith.

Taking the Reserve in this section was Michael Gray, Low Espley with three gimmer shearlings by the £4500 H1 Shrewbridge bought out of Builth as a shearling, which has gone on and done well in the flock. One of the trio was also the Reserve Champion in the open section, having already taken first at the Highland as a gimmer lamb last year and standing third at the Highland again this year in its class.

Top of the tree in the traditional section was a two shear tup from Scott Thomason. This powerful boy is the full brother to the Champion from the Welsh last week, bred at Kirkstead and by the Burndale tup which has done so well for them, out of a ewe bought at the Carry House dispersal as a lamb. He is an immense tup, full of presence and style, traits which caught the eye of the interbreed judge too, who awarded him the interbreed title too, the second in a row for the Walney Island based flock.

In the Mule section, the Championship was taken by Phillip and Denise Elliot with a gimmer shearling and in the lamb section the pairs, which saw over 30 pairs out to judge, quite a line up, and singles were won by Neil Marston, Millstone Moor.



Clark Lamont had the difficult task of judging the event this year at the new venue of Limavady Show. Clark awarded Champion to his first prize gimmer, a very stylish modern sheep by H1 Cottage brought out by J Adams & Sons, Holmview flock. G & J Loughery, Temain were awarded Reserve Champion with their 1st prize aged tup J7 Hamildean.

On to the progeny classes and J Adams & Sons, Holmview again came out on top taking Champion progeny group with J1 Carryhouse and his three quality gimmers. Michelle Wright, Mullaghwee is never far from the limelight at the progeny show and this year was awarded Reserve Champion group with her pair of lambs by J2 Dawyck.

On to the Mule section and this year G & J Loughery, Temain were awarded Champion and Reserve Champion in the individual classes with their 1st and 2nd prize ewe lambs. A glorious day in the South West of Scotland was the setting for the Scottish Bluefaced Leicester progeny show at Dumfries this year. Sheep from across Scotland were on show, with breeders old and new hoping to catch the eyes of the day's judges, Nicky Robinson in the traditional section and Iain Minto in the crossing ring.

The crossing ring saw lain Minto wasting no time to get through his classes, with his Breed Champion coming out of the second class of the day, a tup shearling from Alec and Anders Brown, Macqueston. He was a worthy Champion in most people's eyes, tall, powerful and with the swagger of a true champion in the ring. He was purchased last autumn as a lamb out of Hawes from Carry House in a £12,000 trade with Allanfauld and John Park also investing in him too. He is the full brother to Jackpot who was leading the way at Penrith Progeny Show the previous week, by the G34 Midlock, and out of a ewe by Z4 Hundith bought off Neil Marston. He went on to take the Reserve in a very strong Interbreed championship too.

The Reserve Champion in the crossing section went to Stuart Park from the SP Dalpeddar flock, with a cocky gimmer lamb, sired by a £2200 J22 Old Hemley tup and out of a ewe by another Old Hemley. She was making her show ring debut, but showed herself off well enough to impress the judge.

In the progeny section, it was a clean sweep for Andrew McQuiston, New Luce, where he took both the Champion and Reserve group placings with lambs by a Blarnavaid tup bought off Jamie Pirie last autumn at Stirling for £5500, sharing it with Alan Shennan. He is by the Highberries Hotshot, bought out of Cockermouth for £13,000 by an Oak House tup and again he has that Z4 Hundith breeding on his mother's side. The Champion group were a pair of powerful tup lambs and Reserve were a

trio of gimmer lambs, one of whom had stood first at the Royal Highland Show earlier this summer. The Blarnavaid tups influence ran into the Mule section too, with the top four Mule gimmer lambs at the Royal Highland Show all by him and he went on to take the Mule progeny here, with three cracking gimmer lambs by him from Alan Shennan, proving that good bloodlines run deep and do the job.

The Mule show was won by Alec Brown, Macqueston with a lovely gimmer lamb. She was by a homebred tup lamb used last year, which was sired by, yet again, another Highberries tup. You just can't seem to get away from that breeding at the top of the show lines now!

In the traditional ring there were some very strong classes throughout and Nicky Robinson certainly had his work cut out picking out his winners. As normal though, the cream rises to the top and a one crop ewe from the Rossiebank flock of Robert Neill took the top honours. She was unbeaten on her outings as a gimmer shearling last year and this was her first of the season here, after raising a cracking tup lamb, which Robert isn't 100% sure whether to retain himself or to sell later this autumn. She is by the homebred G11 Rossiebank and on her mother's side she goes back to Hazelwood breeding. She was also part of the pair which took the progeny championship group on this side of the ring too, making it a double for Rossiebank on the day.

The Wales and South West Progeny Show for the Bluefaced Leicester Sheep Breeders' Association was held within Welshpool Livestock Auction by kind permission of Welshpool Livestock Sales. The Welsh Region members turned out another tremendous show of livestock at this year's progeny show. Given the unenviable task of judging this year's show, was respected breeder Alan McClymont from the Scottish Borders who runs the Kirkstead flock of Bluefaced Leicesters who has had a very successful year in the show ring this year.

In the individual classes, Alan awarded his Champion to his female Champion, an outstanding shearling gimmer shown by J McLeod, Wanstead. She was bought as a ewe lamb from Jacqui's neighbour Mick Jones, and is 4609/K016 Fairview. She is sired by the 3649/G002 Wanstead, and out of a Shrewbridge ewe 3114/F035 which is sired by the D4 Lowes Fell.

Taking the Reserve for the second year in a row was the reserve female champion, the eye catching homebred aged ewe from Elfyn Owen, 1070/G057 Cernyw 'Gloria'. She is sired by 4264/D003 Howlea, and out of a homebred ewe sired by 1070/Y001 Cernyw. She has also seen success again in the show ring this year taking the Overall female Championship at the Royal Welsh Show, following that she took the Overall Championship and Overall Interbreed Championship at Anglesey Show. Completing the female section Aled Jones, Craig yr Orsedd took the honours in the ewe lamb class with a sharp homebred lamb by the homebred tup 3363/J25 Craig Yr Orsedd and she is out of a homebred ewe.

The male Champion was awarded to an outstanding homebred shearling ram from T R Harris, Bonvilston 2906/K30, and is sired by 2864/G2 Cendy, and out of a homebred ewe sired by the Broomhills 7/B4. The reserve also came from the Bonvilston flock. This aged ram 2864/G2 was bred by Caleb Thomas, Cendy flock and is sired by the 3363/B4 Craig yr Orsedd. Tudor Harris also took the red rosette in the ram lamb class with an eye catching homebred lamb 2906/L001. He is sired by the T1 Cocklaw out of Shrewbridge 3114/A69 who is the mother of the homebred ram 2906/C1 which was sold for 4000 gns as a four year old

at the NSA Wales & Border Ram Sales at Builth Wells in 2013 to the Burndale flock, and he later went on to sire the Breed Champion in the traditional section at the Royal Highland Show in 2016 and repeating the success in 2018. News From You

Bluefaced Leicester Regions

North East

Once again, the season starts with the Great Yorkshire Show, and it didn't disappoint, with more entries seen this year than in more recent years without diluting the quality of stock on show. Geoff Porter of Riddings ably handling the task of judging the fine selection on offer this year. The Graham's of Stirling travelled down and the trip was well worth it. They won most of the classes and took the overall championship with an aged ewe.

The first registered sale of the year took place at Hexham and sale prices peaked at £900 for the overall champion, a shearling tup presented by Alan and Peter Forster, Lowes Fell. Trade throughout at this sale could be epitomised by describing buyers as 'very discerning and cautious choosing very selectively'.

The Hawes Bluefaced Leicester sale seemed to buck the trend of the many disappointing breed sales seen up and down the country this year. 755 sheep were brought forward for this sale. The Steel topped the market at 220,000, then Firth 216,000; Midlock 216,000; Carry House 211,000; Smearsett 211,000; and Hewgill 210,000 with Mr Shennan who judged the old tup classes also getting in on the act and making 210,000. This made the lamb average 21354 this year – an average down by over 2200 this year despite the few 'high price tag' achievements listed here. Sellers seemed uplifted somewhat by the day's sale despite the background doom and gloom noises of the agriculture bill making its way through Parliament and the impending Brexit challenges to come.

Ram lambs were efficiently judged by Martyn Mawson who gave the championship to M James of Duhonw with 2nd prize to M/s Porter, Riddings; 3rd to M Allan, Greenhow and 4th to R D Archer & Son, Carry House.

Old tups and tup shearlings were judged by Alan Shennan who gave the 1st prize old tup to Ty-Gwyn which later realised £800. 1st tup shearling prize winner was from Otterburn lodge selling for £4,600. Gimmer shearling prize went to Marriforth which also took reserve female prize, and realised £1,600 and the Marriforth flock gimmer lamb won the female championship and overall reserve champion [not sold]. Riddings were 1st and 2nd placed in the ewe class and realised £650 and £1300 respectively.

Lastly, a big thank you to all the staff at Hexham and Hawes for their hard work on the day [which for Hawes this year did end just before midnight]! A lot of hard work goes into these sale days and both buyers and sellers appreciate the professional and smooth flow of sheep selling throughout the day. Laurence Allison - Chairman

Carlisle sale was held at H & H, Borderway Mart on 12th October with 1227 Bluefaced Leicesters on offer through three rings. The traditional type Overall Champion was awarded to Fraser Kennedy, AE Water, with an aged ewe - G4 AE Water. Reserve went to M & N Gray, Espley with the male Champion, a tup lamb, L3 Espley. The top price in the traditional classes came from Frank Johnson, with a tup lamb, L2 Ashes, selling for £3,900. 200 tup lambs averaged £445, 41 aged/shearling tups £485 and 63 females £374. The crossing type Overall Champion came from Amy Campbell, Glenrath, with a tup lamb L2 Glenrath, with the Reserve going to the female Champion from M/s Jones, Llanilltyd with their gimmer lamb, L26 Llanilltyd. Top price in the crossing type came from the Shafthill flock with a tup lamb, L12 Shafthill, making £9,000. 290 tup lambs averaged £843, 151 shearling tups £649 and 27 females £333.

Many thanks to our members who provided quality sheep for the Association stand.

At the Royal Highland Show, the Bluefaced Leicester traditional Champion was an old tup from Kirkstead and the reserve champion, a gimmer from Cassington went on to win the Overall Interbreed Pairs award with an amazing double act resulting from the crossing type pair, both from Midlock taking the reserve interbreed pairs title.

At the 2018 Progeny Show at Dumfries, the crossing type Champion, a shearling from Macqueston went on to be awarded reserve interbreed. Champion traditional blue was a ewe from Rossiebank.

At the first of the sales, Kelso produced averages for blues that held up well at \pounds 940, the same as 2016, although slightly down on the previous year. Top price Bluefaced Leicester at \pounds 8,000 was from Obie Sharp at Newbigging Walls, and the top price in the traditional lines came from John Dykes, Mendick selling at \pounds 6,500.

The Hawes sale produced a top of $\pounds 20,000$ from the Steel and second top price was equalled by Scottish breeders Midlock and Firth both selling to a top of $\pounds 16,000$. Several other Scottish consignors also featured in the top lots of the day.

Numbers forward were down at the Castle Douglas sale, but trade was much better than expected with averages up by £110 and £115 for shearlings and lambs respectively. The top price of £2,500 was for a shearling from Culdoach. The Champion, a shearling from Finniness made £1,500 and the Reserve Champion, a tup lamb from Macqueston made £1,400.

South West

"I think 2018 will go down as one of the most challenging years for a very long time. A harsh, prolonged winter lead to a difficult lambing season due to the weather. Lambs were slow to start and waited a long time to have the sun on their backs. Winter bypassed spring and jumped straight into a hot, dry summer with light crops of silage and hay. 



The 2018 Ballinrobe sale saw the club's biggest entry of sheep with 139 cataloged for sale. As with most of the sales this season, trade was somewhat subdued, however, shearling rams were up on the year with more sheep forward in this section. Buyers were looking for big powerful sheep and clean colour.

57 ram lambs sold to average 585 Euros - down 40 Euros on the previous year, with 25 less sold. 32 lambs went unsold. Sale Champion was a powerful, clean marked ram lamb from Joe Scahill's Faughburren flock. This lamb picked up many red tickets in the show season throughout the summer which included winning its class at the Tullamore Show. He was bred by the 5500 gns Mullaghwee bought in partnership with the Mask View flock at Ballymena in 2017 from Michelle Wright. Reserve Champion was a ram lamb from Tom Staunton's Mask View flock, again from the same bloodlines as the Champion. Champion and Reserve Champion were unsold. Top price lamb came from the Faughburren flock selling for 1460 Euros. Third prize ram lamb from new breeder Johnathan Wall sold at 1210 Euros, and this lamb was bred out of last year's Ballinrobe Champion ram lamb from the Woodview flock. Other top prices included 1100 Euros - Faughburren flock, 1010 Euros - Mask View Flock.

In the shearling section, trade was up on the year with many buyers preferring a mature ram. Twenty seven shearlings sold to average 740 Euros, up 100 Euros on 2017. Seven shearlings sold over 1000 Euros. First prize went to John Morahan's Woodview flock. This powerful sheep was bred by 4331 Glenshane J1 and sold for 1300 Euros. Top priced

shearling came from the Faughburren flock, bred by 4345 Woodview J1 and sold at 1400 Euros. Faughburren also received 1040 Euros and 1000 Euros. The second prize shearling came from the Mask View flock bred by 3678 Caoramor J2 and sold for 1100 Euros. Two shearlings from David and Allister Lyttle sold for 1120 Euros bred by Craig Yr Orsedd K10 and 1020 Euros bred by Holmview J2.

There was a small entry in the female section. Six females, all ewe lambs sold to average 300 Euros. First prize ewe lamb came from Paul Sammon's Firmount flock and sold for a top price of 330 Euros and was bred by Mullaghwee K18.

A big thanks from the club to Dominic McCrystal from the Drummuck flock who judged the pre-sale show. He did a fantastic job on the day, casting his experienced and sharp eye on the stock presented.
